### Aubergines

- 1<sup>st</sup> – Karen & John                    Difficult to grow in the UK. Well done!  
 2<sup>nd</sup> – Vlad & Gintare                Very unusual aubergines. Well done!

### Brassicas

- 1<sup>st</sup> – Laura & Rob                      Excellent size red cabbage. Perfect density & colour inside.  
 2<sup>nd</sup> – Andrea Legrand                Large and uniform kale, good head, very clean.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> – Faith Painter                    Good, dense cabbage heads but outer leaves lacking finesse.

### Chilli Peppers

- 1<sup>st</sup> – Dan Read                         Uniform shape and size. Good flesh, no markings or splits.  
 2<sup>nd</sup> – ???                                 Black chillies, uniform shape and size. Good colour.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> – Andrew Stanley                Some surface markings, good colour & good flesh. Not uniform.

### Cucumbers

 2<sup>nd</sup> – Gill Hiley                         Uniform shape, good colour & flavour, crunchy.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> – Helen Morris                    Tasty, ripe with crunchy taste. Some skin damage.

### Legumes

 2<sup>nd</sup> – Faith Painter                    Uniform size, nice colour.
